8. Scholarship funds will only be awarded to the student's college or university account upon evidence of registration in an accredited post-secondary institution.

2. Applicant must demonstrate positive-impact involvement – in the complete sense – consistent with capacity and circumstances and/or significant improvement/success in scholarship and school involvement, determined through letters of recommendation.

1. Applicant must submit the following items:
2. Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
3. Proof of admittance to college/university or post-secondary educational institution
4. Two (2) letters of recommendations from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individuals with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
5. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average.
6. Personal Essay. In your essay, please answer the questions of the impact you have made to the school during your tenure and your plans to continue to be a positive alumni in 500-800 words.
