1 MEET WITH YOUR COLLEGE ADVISERS!

2 CREATE ACCOUNTS NECESSARY TO APPLY TO/ATTEND COLLEGE

Creating accounts on the following websites will allow you to register for admissions exams, complete college applications, and plan for college

- CommonApp: commonapp.org
- College Board (SAT): collegeboard.org
- ACT: act.org

3 REGISTER FOR ADMISSIONS EXAMS

Sign up to take or retake exams such as SAT, ACT, ACCUPLACER, or ASVAB. Create a list that includes test fees, dates, and registration deadlines

4 COMPLETE AND SUBMIT THE FAFSA (FINANCIAL AID)

To apply for most financial aid, you **MUST** complete the FAFSA. **October 1** is the first day you can file the FAFSA. It is **FREE!**

5 PREPARE FOR EARLY ACTION OR EARLY DECISION ADMISSION DEADLINES

Early decision and early action applications are typically due in November of your senior year, Colleges may require test scores for early decision admission.

Please note: UGA and GA Tech Early Action Deadlines are October 15



6 COMPLETE AT LEAST 1 COLLEGE APPLICATION BY THANKSGIVING

Send proof to Ms. Hairston or Ms. Cawley of your completed applications to be entered in a **raffle**. 1 application = 1 ticket
